
# NATIVITY OF OUR LORD PARISH JUNE 19 - JUNE 23, 2023

The following guideline is to assist Nativity Parish families in the selection of the Summer PREP program for their child(ren)'s method of Religious Education.

#### What is the Summer PREP Program?

The Summer PREP program is an intensive one week Religious Education program that is an alternative to the traditional weekly program. Total class hours are similar to the traditional program. There will be 30 hours of onsite learning, with an additional requirement of 5 Faith based activities throughout the year.

## **Dates and Times of the Program**

Summer PREP will be offered the week of June 19 through June 23, 2023 from 9:00AM to 3:30PM, Monday through Friday.

## **Requirements for Successful Completion**

- Must be present for all five days of onsite class time. Due to the intensity of the
  program, and the amount of material covered, child(ren) will not be permitted to arrive
  late and/or leave early. Illness or emergency absence will invalidate attendance in
  Summer PREP, and the child(ren) will need to be enrolled in the traditional Wednesday
  evening program to complete the PREP level. There will not be any makeup sessions or
  work to substitute for attendance.
- Attendance at Lenten PREP Confessions on Wednesday evening-Levels 3 through 7 (date TBD).
- Sacramental preparation levels (Levels 3 & 7) will be required to attend a certain number of Wednesday evening classes, as the reception of the Sacrament draws near. Therefore, Level 3 will have a Wednesday evening class requirement leading up to the reception of First Reconciliation in November, and the reception of First Holy Communion in May. Level 7 will have Wednesday evening class requirement leading up to reception of Confirmation in March, dates to be determined. The Confirmation Saint project will be required for all Confirmation candidates. Families will know well in advance which Wednesday evenings are required for Sacramental attendance.

## Attendance at all Sacrament retreats and practices is mandatory.

In addition to the one week intensive, 5 Faith based activities must be completed
throughout the year and before the start of the subsequent Summer program. Failure to
complete these requirements will prohibit registration in the Summer program going
forward. In order to track these activities, a short reflection will need to be submitted
to the PREP office. Families will be provided with a standardized form; one form per
activity. There is an expectation that PREP families attend Mass weekly, and on Holy

Days of Obligation, so these are not eligible for the Faith based activities. Attendance at family events such as a funeral or wedding Mass, a Baptism, First Communion, or Confirmation Mass are not eligible as well. A list of suggested activities is contained at the end of this guideline. Faith based activities should be reflective of prayer and worship, as well as a family's participation in the life of Nativity Parish.

# **Eligibility Requirements**

To participate in the Summer program, families must be registered Nativity parishioners. Current child(ren) enrolled in Nativity PREP, and who are in good standing, are eligible for registration. Class sizes will be limited, so acceptance will be on a first come, first serve basis. There will be only one class of each Level, 1 through 7. Once a class is filled, registration for that level will be closed. *Children who are out of sequence and have not had any previous Religious Education are not candidates for the Summer program.* 

# **Program Staffing**

The Nativity Summer PREP program will be staffed by professional teachers, and parent/guardian volunteers. Professional teachers will serve as Catechists, and parent/guardian volunteers will be in an assistant capacity only.

## Fee Structure

The Summer PREP fee reflects an increase over the traditional program. Summer PREP is staffed by professional teachers, and the fee charged reflects this increased cost. There is no hardship allowance for the Summer PREP fee. The traditional Wednesday evening program is available in the event of financial hardship.

1 Student- \$250 2 Students- \$500 3 Students- \$600

As with the traditional program, registration will be electronic through Parish Giving. Registration for the Summer program will be opened in February, date TBD, and families will be notified via email and the Parish bulletin.

There is a fee discount for those parents/guardians volunteering their time in the Summer program. It will be prorated based on the hours of service.

#### **Additional Considerations:**

- There are no food services in the program. Families will need to provide a peanut free lunch, snack, and water bottle daily.
- All policies contained in the NOOLP PREP Family Handbook will apply to the Summer program, such as student code of conduct, arrival/dismissal procedures, dress code, parental custody agreements, cell/technology policy, etc.
- Child(ren) may dress comfortably but appropriately during the Summer PREP week, with the exception of the following: no tank tops, midriff tops, extremely short shorts, and flip flops. Dress should be appropriate for participation in Church activities such as Mass, Adoration, Church tour, etc.
- Safe Environment lessons (KidTalk) will be presented to all levels during one of the class days. This is an Archdiocesan requirement. Families will be given the opportunity to optout of this small portion of class time, just as in the traditional program.
