In the glory of God the Father. Amen.

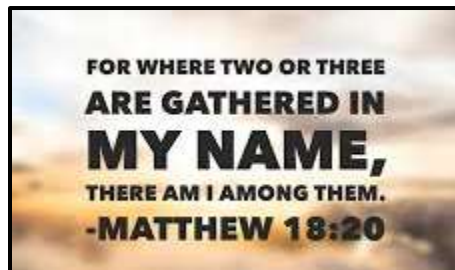
