2. Pick an organization from the list below, purchase the gift and drop off at the Community Center on Giving Tree Day. No need to tell us ahead of time which one you are doing. ***Please mark your gift with the name of the organization.***

- Father Doug McCay, ***Our House Ministries*** an outreach for drug and alcohol addiction. Father is requesting t shirts, underwear, socks and any gift cards to ShopRite or Acme.
- Sister Ann Provost, RSM ***Mercy Neighborhood Ministries Adult Daycare*** requests gift cards for Rite Aid drugstore, a store that is nearby the Sisters' North Philadelphia facility
- Barbara Coleman, ***Mercy Ministries after School Care*** our longstanding partner, requests donations of any amount. The check, payable to Mercy Neighborhood Ministries support working parents whose children attend preschool and after-school care
- Cathy and Dave Wagner, who represent the ***Military Outreach, Willow Grove Airbase***, request gift cards to Shop-Rite, Target, Walmart to support military families
