*Refrain*

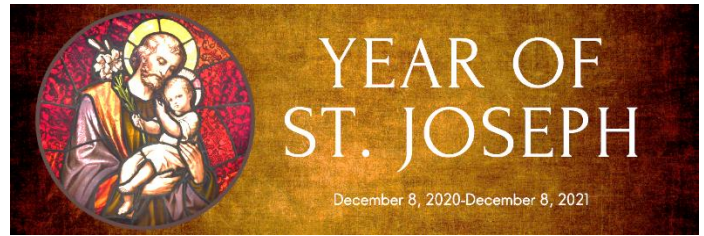
I, the Lord of wind and flame, I will tend the poor and lame

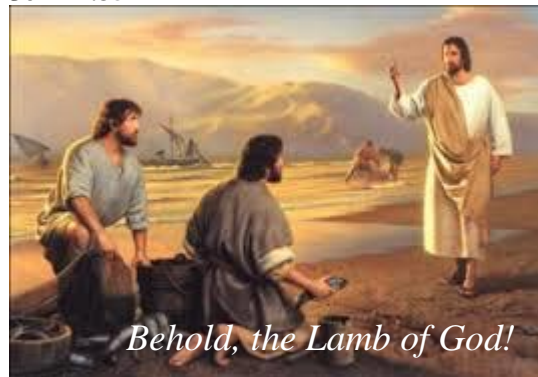

### Profession of Faith
