Profession of Faith

 know the Lord. REFRAIN

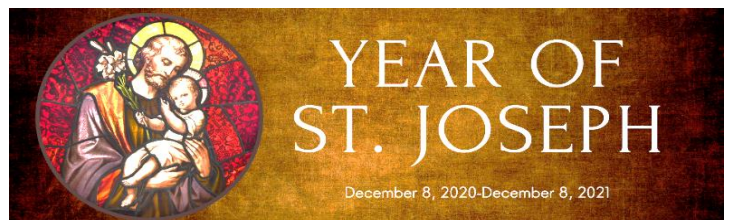
Blessing & Dismissal
